Şiyyôn - God's Kingdom Restoration

Operational Summary

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1. What is Şiyyôn practically?

Şiyyôn – Kingdom Restoration is:

- ➔ **An Ekklesia spiritually** – a community of called-out Kingdom people living Christ’s model beyond religion and institutionalisation.
- ➔ **A Movement** – restoring God’s intended design for His people before infiltration, bringing reformation, healing, and Kingdom truth.

2. What does Şiyyôn do?

I. Prayer & Worship

- Prayer walks and intercessory gatherings. Events
- Worship as lifestyle gatherings – free, participatory, Spirit-led.

II. Teaching & Discipleship

- Online teachings, Bible studies, and prayer meetings.
- In-person gatherings, communal meals, worship sessions, and outreach preparation.
- Focus on **Kingdom identity, truth, gifts, and purpose**.

III. Community Outreach

- Food, clothing, and essentials distribution.
- Women and youth empowerment programs.
- Connecting people to legal, educational, health, and spiritual support.

IV. Kingdom Empowerment

- Helping people identify and grow in their spiritual gifts and life purpose.
- Encouraging Kingdom businesses, skills training, and practical life equipping.

3. How will Şiyyôn operate?

- **Servant-leadership model**
- **Founder** leads vision, teachings, and strategic direction
- **Support teams (as God sends)** handle admin, programs, finances, outreach
- **Everyone participates.**
- **Participatory gatherings:**
People share, learn, pray, read scriptures and ministers as the Spirit leads, worship freely.
- **No rigid hierarchy, no membership rolls.**

4. Where will Şiyyôn gather?

- **Initial Phase:** Homes, public spaces, rented venues for gatherings and outreach.
- **Online platforms:** WhatsApp groups, Zoom, private community site for discipleship.
- **Long-term:** Permanent community centres or spaces as God provides.

5. How is Şiyyôn different from a church?

- Not an institutional denomination or structured church service model.
- It is **Ekklesia** – called-out believers living Kingdom life daily, gathering in simplicity and truth, equipping each other, and going out to impact the world.

6. How will people join?

- No forced membership.
- People participate by joining teachings, gatherings, and outreach.
- Discipled into maturity, gifts, and purpose, eventually leading or supporting areas as God directs.

7. How programs and initiatives start without money or people?

→ **Start with what God gives:**

- Online prayer and teaching group
- First outreach - **5K Prayer Walk** as our public introduction - building awareness and community
- Small committed core team

→ God will provide **people, resources, and sponsors step by step** as faithfulness and obedience unfold.

8. The Phased Approach

➤ Phase 1 (July – Dec 2025):

- Host first outreach (5K Prayer Walk)
- Finalise registration
- Build online discipleship community

➤ Phase 2 (Dec 2025 – 2026):

- Launch women's and youth programs | Men's Development
- Strengthen community outreach
- Start skill and empowerment initiatives

➤ Phase 3 (2026 onwards):

- Develop income-generating initiatives
- Establish permanent community spaces
- Expand teachings regionally or globally

Şiyyôn is God's reformation assignment.

We build one step at a time, Spirit-led, Christ-centred, for His glory alone.

9. Why register as a Foundation?

- Required by Jamaican law for outreach, programs, and donations.
- Protects the vision legally and builds credibility with partners.
- Registration does not define our spiritual identity, it only ensures legal compliance and credibility.
